

CAPITALIZATION : Sentences, Titles, Days, Months, People

- ∅ The first word of a sentence is capitalized.

Please sing your name on the line at the bottom.

- ∅ The names of people and pets are capitalized. So are people's initials and titles.

David Jacobson - Buck - Mr. Alfonso Garcia, Jr.

- ∅ Words used to name relatives are capitalized only when the words are used as names or as part of names. They are not capitalized when preceded by a possessive pronoun, such as my, your or his.

Will Dad pick up Mother at the train station?
I like staying with my grandmother

- ∅ The names of days, months and holidays are capitalized, but the names of seasons are not.

On Monday, March 12, Sasha will interview the mayor.
Our family always has a picnic on Independence Day

- ∅ The pronoun I is capitalized.

Michael and I went to the video store.
