

PLURAL NOUNS

Plural nouns are formed in the following ways:

- ∅ Most nouns, add " s " girls, friends
- ∅ Nouns ending in s, sh, ch, or x, add " es " boxes, churches
- ∅ Nouns ending in y preceded by a consonant, change " y " to " i " and add " es " body - bodies
- ∅ Nouns ending in " y " preceded by a vowel, add just " s " toy - toys, boy - boys
- ∅ Some nouns ending in " o ", add " s " . radios echoes
some ending in " o " preceded by a consonant, add " es "
- ∅ (dictionary) many nouns ending in " f " or " fe " , change the " f " to " v " and add " es " or " s " calf - calves
Some nouns ending in " f " add knife - knives
only " s " chief - chiefs
- ∅ A few nouns, make no change between the singular and plural. one sheep, two sheep
one moose, two moose
- ∅ A few nouns form the plural irregularly
goose - geese
child - children
woman - women
man - men
mouse - mice
die - dice
foot - feet
tooth - teeth
