

## POSSESSIVE NOUNS

A possessive noun shows ownership of a noun that follows.

### Remember:

∅ A noun is a word that names a person, place, thing, or idea.

The following rules show how to form the possessive of nouns:

∅ If the noun is " singular ", add an " apostrophe and s ".

I'm going to my sister's new office.

Cass's job is public relations director of the national fair.

∅ If the noun is " plural and ends in s ", add an " apostrophe only ".

This national fair is on the cities' showcase.

∅ If the noun is " plural and does not end in s ", add an " apostrophe and s ".

The fair has a children's pavilion
