

## REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS

### PRESENT TENSE:

Present tense is same as "INFINITIVE " but not " TO "

### At the 3<sup>rd</sup> sing. person:

- ∅ For the verbs that end with " E " we add " S "
- ∅ For the verbs that end with a " CONSONANT + Y " change " Y " for " IES " .

Example : To fly – he/she/it *flies*.

- ∅ For the verbs that end with " SH, CH, S, X, O " add " ES " .

<u>Examples:</u>  TO FLY  I fly You fly He/she/it flies We fly You fly They fly	TO DO  I do You do He/she/it does We do You do They do	TO FIX  I fix You fix He/she/it fixes We fix You fix They fix

## REGULAR VERBS

### PAST TENSE:

- ∅ Add " ED " at the verbs (all persons)

Ex.: I walk                      I walked, he/she/it walked

- ∅ Add only " D " to the verbs that end by " E "

Ex.: To love                      she loved

- ∅ For one syllable verb : " CONSONANT + VOWEL + CONSONANT "

you double de last letter and add " ED "

Ex.: To stop                      I stopped

- ∅ The verbs that end with " CONSONANT + Y " change the " Y " for " IED "

Ex.: To try                      tried  
      To play                     played  
      To carry                    carried
